#### Singapore Nursing Award

**Study Title:** The Impact of the Number of Previous Illness Episodes on Outcome in Electroconvulsive Therapy (ECT) in Psychosis, Mania, Depression, Psychotic depression, and Catatonia: A naturalistic transdiagnostic analysis

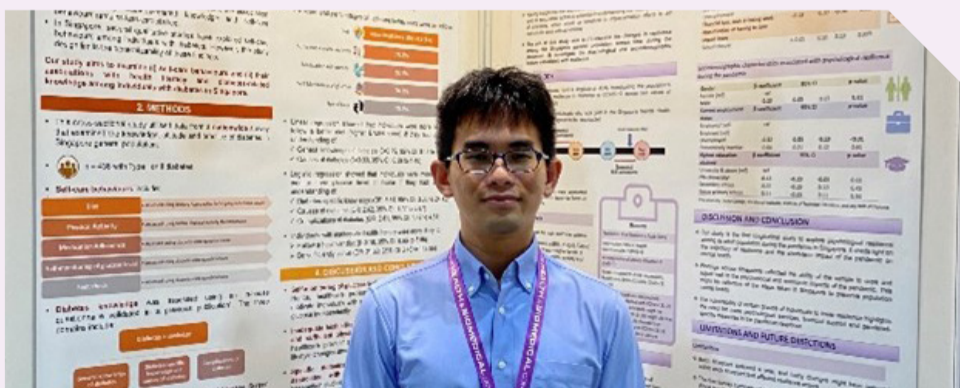
**Study Aim:** The aim of the study is to investigate the relationship between the number of previous illness episodes and the symptomatic improvement after acute ECT treatment.

**Study Aim:** The study aims to describe the indications for ECT in adolescents and compare their symptom, cognition, and quality of life outcomes.

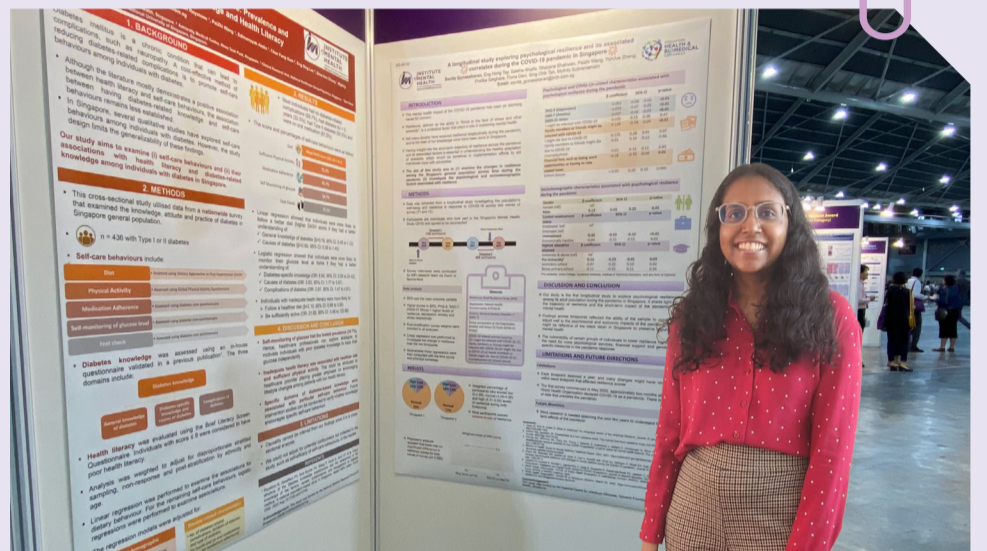

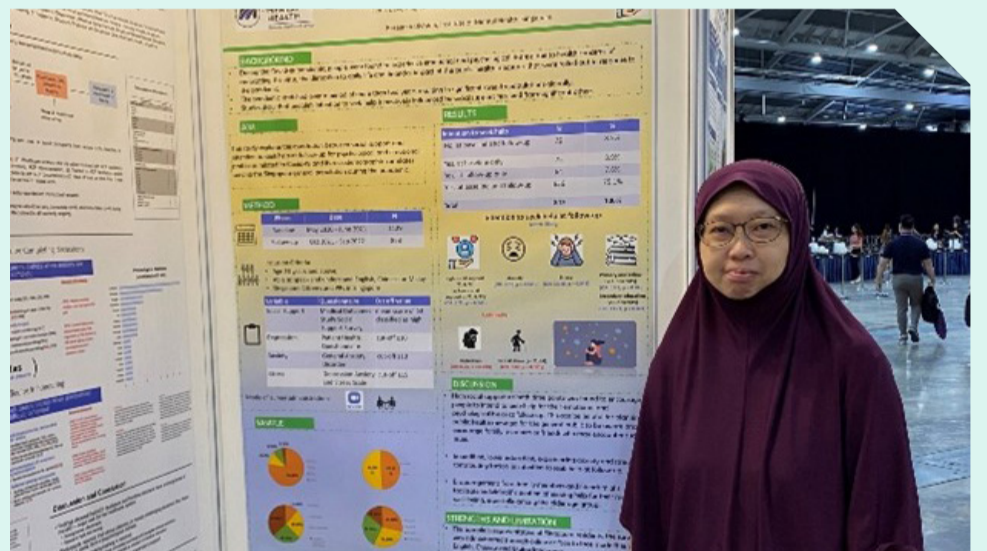

**Study Title:** A longitudinal study exploring psychological resilience and its associated correlates during the COVID-19 pandemic in Singapore

**Study Aim:** The aim of the study was to examine the changes in resilience among the Singapore general population across time during the pandemic and to investigate the sociodemographic and psychological factors associated with resilience in this population.
