

AUTISM DIAGNOSTIC INTERVIEW – REVISED (ADI-R)

Course Description

The ADI-R is a standardised, semi-structured diagnostic interview for use with the parents or caregivers of people with Autism Spectrum Disorders. The interview focuses upon three main areas (i) quality of reciprocal social interaction, (ii) communication and language, and (iii) repetitive, restricted and stereotyped patterns of behaviour.

The 2.5 days ADI-R training course is suitable for those who wish to use the ADI-R for clinical purposes. It is recommended that all trainees complete the post course activities (coding and administration practice tasks); however these are only mandatory for those who wish to use the ADI-R in research.

Prior to attending the course, you will receive a pre-course information pack, containing information about the venue and materials. In addition, you will receive an ADI-R administration for you to watch prior to attending the course. You will also be asked to do a practice administration of the ADI-R for the Advanced Training. This can be done with the parent of a child with autism, or as a role play exercise with a friend or colleague. This task is to help you become familiarize with the ADI-R, and is a very useful preparation for the workshop. Detailed information on this will be provided in the pre-course pack. It is also required that you read the ADI-R manual prior to attending the workshop.

Who can participate in the training workshop?

The ADI-R is intended for use by both clinicians and researchers. The workshop is designed for psychologists, pediatricians, and psychiatrists. Speech pathologists, occupational therapists, and doctoral students who have experience in standardized assessment measures, and familiar to Autism Spectrum Disorders and other related conditions, are also able to attend the training workshops.
